Will I have access to the library?

Only ATC Students, faculty and Staff will have access to the library. You must have your student ID with the current sticker in order to enter the library. The library hours will be posted on our webpage at <https://library.augustatech.edu/>

Will there be a limited number of people allowed in the library?

Yes, we must adhere to CDC guidelines. Face covering is required in our building.

Will I have access to the computers?

Will the study rooms be available?

Study rooms are only available on the Augusta campus. Study rooms will be available by appointment only. Only one person will be allowed in the study room.
